The first is called Srijan- a weaver's dream, where we have been working with a community of pit loom weavers to help them enhance their business practises to expand their markets and incomes. The second project is the Good Touch and Bad Touch Campaign in Government Primary schools to create awareness about child sexual abuse and protective measures that they can undertake to protect themselves. Aan has been empanelled with the Uttarakhand Commission for Protection of Child Rights for conducting these workshops.

An Awareness Campaign on "स्वच्छ भारत, स्वस्थ भारत, सशक्त भारत" was organized by Aan in association with Social Service Club Delhi Public School, Mathura Road, New Delhi, at a Primary School in Jagatpurpatti, Jaspur, Uttarakhand. A Drawing competition was conducted and a Nukkad Natak was presented for the underprivileged children of 'Pit loom Weavers' of the area. A total of 38 children participated in two age categories. We conducted an impactful program with an overwhelming response.



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

An awareness campaign for women empowerment and girl child welfare was organized at the Government Primary School of Manorathpur, Jaspur on Independence Day. The National Insurance Company contributed significantly in creating a sense of awareness about the importance of life insurance among the villagers. AAN sponsored and distributed two types of life insurance policies, Bhagyashree and Rajrajeshwari. The policies were distributed free of cost to 25 young girls and 25 women belonging to the artisan community. Melodious songs, nukkad natak, poems and dances energized the whole environment. The event was a huge success and enlightened the whole village community.
