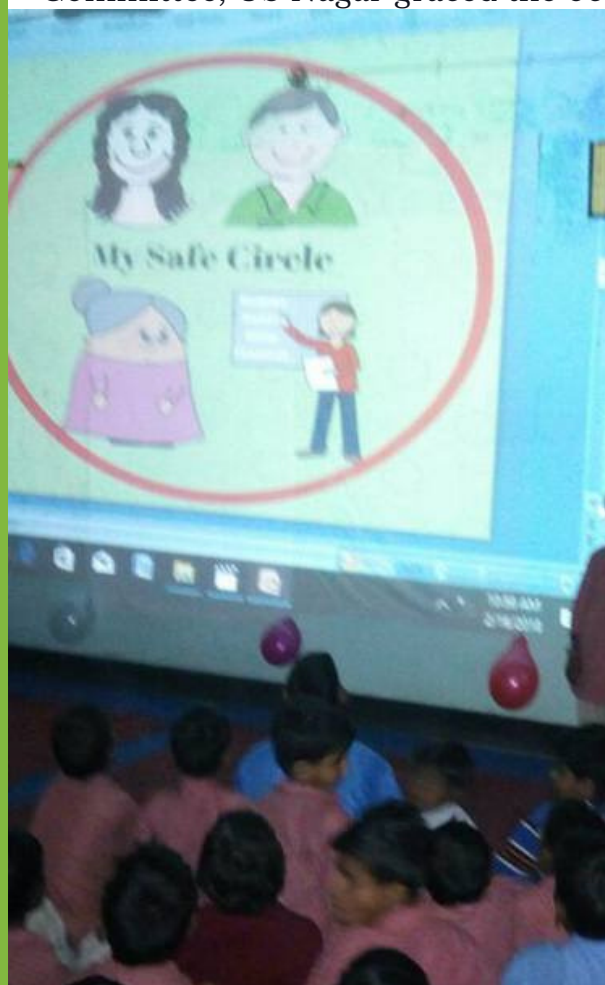
REPUBLIC DAY- GTBT CAMPAIGN

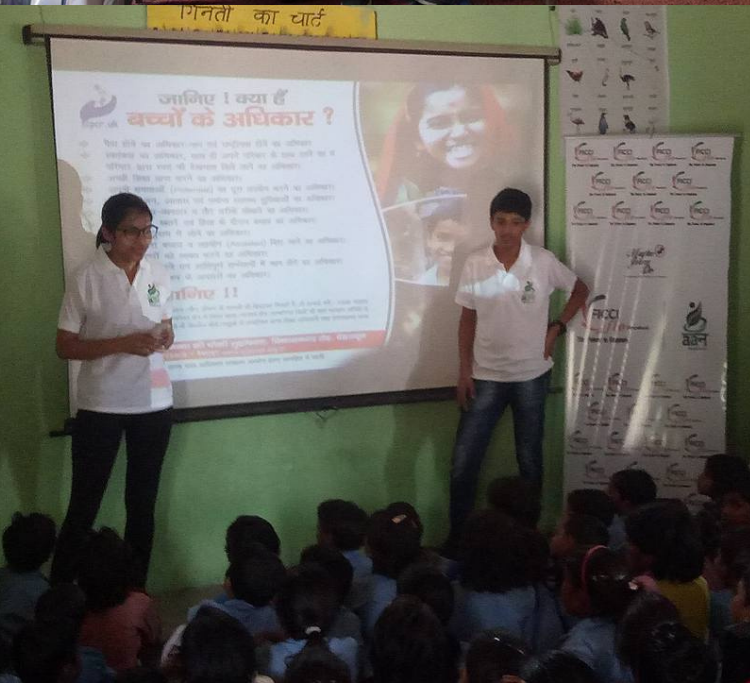
SENSITIZING SPECIALLY ABLED CHILDREN

Volunteers of AAN took up the challenge of sensitizing the 76 specially abled children of Janet Sheed Roberts Residential School, Ramnagar. As a dual learning process our team of Private school children interacted with a mixed group of hearing impaired & physically handicapped children who are excelling in academics and vocational training, to gain an insight into their lives.
